Oral presentations must consist of a 10 minute presentation with 5 minutes for questions.

Please present your poster in person. If your application is successful you will be sent details of appropriate poster size and format.

Both posters and oral presentations should be presented in language suitable to an audience drawn from a range of different disciplines.

Applications must clearly state your name, School, field of research, whether you are submitting a poster or an oral presentation, the provisional title of your research poster or oral presentation and

provide an abstract of your research in no more than 300 words. Please stick to one A4 page. One figure with figure caption may be included.

Abstract Requirements

The conference audience will consist of researchers from across the two colleges of LES and EPS, working in a range of different disciplines. Therefore, we are looking for text specifically aimed at a broad audience. Please note that if your abstract is deemed incoherent or too technical, you may be contacted by the selection panel and asked to make amendments.

Your abstract will be shortlisted on the basis of the following criteria:

- 1. Your abstract should have an engaging title that attracts non-specialists' attention
- 2. Your abstract should have a clear outline describing the originality and impact of your research
- 3. You should use jargon-free language where technical terms are explained clearly wherever possible

What Happens Next

If your abstract is accepted for the Postdoctoral Researcher Conference (EPS & LES), we will aim to inform you within 4-5 weeks and you will be asked to submit your research poster or oral presentation.

Please be aware that due to limitations on time and space at the conference, it may not be possible for all posters and oral presentations submitted to be selected for presentation at the conference.

Prizes

There will be a prize available for the best oral presentation and for the runner up, as judged by a panel. There will be a prize for the best poster as judged by a panel and for the best poster as voted on by the conference delegates.
