Water Conservators Bursary

The Worshipful Company of Water Conservators* has generously awarded the MSc River Environments and their Management programme a bursary of £4,000 this year “to assist a student [or students] who may find themselves in difficulty with the payment of their course fees”. Application details are given below.

Water Conservators Dissertation Support Grant

The Water Conservators have also awarded the MSc programme a £1,000 support grant “to assist any student members of the course in meeting specific expenses connected with the research they need to carry out to complete their dissertations”. Application will be at the time of choosing a dissertation (project).

Application Process for the Water Conservators Bursary

All students with an offer of a place on the MSc programme in River Environments and their Management can apply for funding from the Bursary. An application form is attached. The closing date for applications for the 2018/19 session is **Friday 31st August 2018**. Awards take into account financial need and academic ability. The award will be made by reduction of the fee for the programme rather than in cash. Further conditions of an award are as follows: (a) the student must have the right (and intention) to work in (or from) the United Kingdom following their MSc; (b) recipients may be asked to make presentations to industry or professional bodies based on their MSc topic studies.
