KEY INFORMATION FOR VISITING SCHOLAR APPLICANTS

- (i) You will have access to staff within the School of Geography, Earth and Environmental Sciences who are involved in relevant and related research topics;
- (ii) You will have the opportunity to attend relevant open seminars within the School and University;
- (iii) Any publications arising from your research while in the School should acknowledge the School and the University;
- (iv) We will identify any opportunities for you to participate as appropriate in relevant research projects to help you further your research aims;
- (v) You will cover all of your costs (travel, living, etc.) during the period, with no direct costs falling on the University of Birmingham.
- (vi) You will be responsible for your own relevant medical and personal insurance.
- (vii) The School normally charges a bench fee of £2,000 per annum for visitors. You have free access to Information Services, photocopying and phone facilities. However, if the latter results in above average usage we will reserve the right to charge you direct (e.g. for overseas phone calls, large photocopying requirements, etc.). Please note that space in the School is extremely limited and we can only guarantee a "hot" desk in a multi-user research room but no dedicated computer.
- (viii) You will be responsible for arranging your own living accommodation, although advice can be given on local private rental accommodation. Please note that University accommodation is limited.
- (ix) You will be responsible for relevant visas etc for entry to, and work in, the UK.
- (x) We will arrange for you to hold Associate Membership of the University for the period to enable your access to University facilities.
