We're very pleased to say that MifeMiso recruitment is off to a flying start—very well done to teams at all our sites who have recruited their first ladies and best of luck to those who are yet to recruit!

A special congratulations is due to the team at Sunderland who recruited 3 ladies in just 9 days! MifeMiso officially opened to recruitment on 20th September 2017 and so far 14 ladies have been recruited to date.



We now have a total of 13 hospitals which are open to recruitment with several more sites to open shortly!

OSSA OF EARLY PRECNANCY

If a woman knows the exact date of her LMP or the whole number of weeks since her LMP to the date of missed miscarriage diagnosis then this information will be used to calculate gestational age in days. Unfortunately if the woman is over 13+6wks according to LMP but is within 13+6wks according to their ultrasound scan then these ladies will be ineligible. If a woman doesn't know when her LMP was then gestational age is calculated from the ultrasound scan

Satisfaction surveys

The patient satisfaction surveys (CSQ-8 questionnaire) have to be purchased from a company called Tamalpais Matrix Systems, LLC according to the number required rather than paying a set fee. Therefore please take care of these questionnaires as unfortunately we don't have a bottomless budget and cannot simply print endless copies of these! Thanks for your cooperation!



Reminders



Queries—Check your list of queries to action in the database on a **regular** basis (using the **monitoring** tab)—we will send monthly reminders to the main research nurses and midwives at each site



Screening logs—Enter screening log data in to the database on *at least* a monthly basis (or enter as you go along)—we will send monthly reminders to the main research nurses and midwives at each site




Day 21—Call ladies at day 21 to obtain their pregnancy test result and remind them to complete the satisfaction survey and EQ-5D-5L questionnaire and post back to the trial office if their result is negative. Remember to highlight the opportunity of participating in a follow up interview to women




Data entry—Check data entry completeness regularly using the alerts tab. Ensure data entry is done promptly—in particular please ensure the Outcomes form is fully completed once a lady obtains a negative pregnancy test result and is discharged from EPU care—it is very important for the trial office to be aware once a lady has been discharged so we know to expect their questionnaires
