**Thank you for your patience.** We can finally start the programme!


additional delays in a few practices where the GP has been unavailable to check the list of patients identified. However, following discussions with the practices alternative GPs have been identified to carry out these checks.

Of 488 patients identified as eligible on the initial sweep, around half (53%) had already been referred for further investigation. Around a quarter (27%) of patients identified by the programme may benefit from a check-up for bowel disease, with 18% definitely eligible for a review.



Our challenge..... is to see how quickly we can get eligible patients seen and then referred as appropriate.
