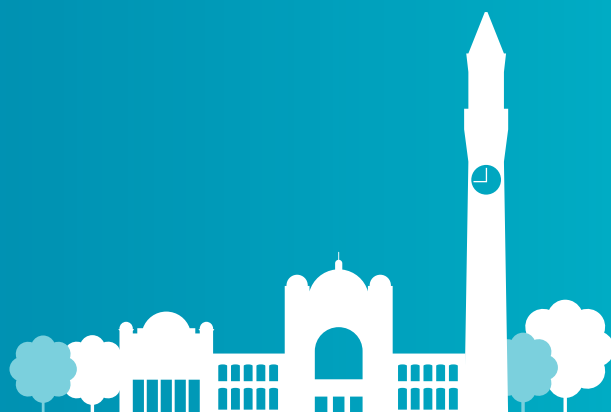


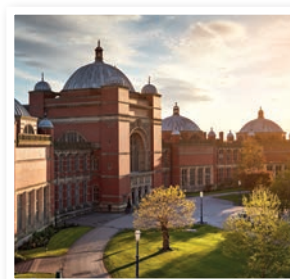

Fine art gallery with extensive selection of galleries and exhibitions, housed in one of Birmingham's finest Art Deco buildings. **(Free entry)**

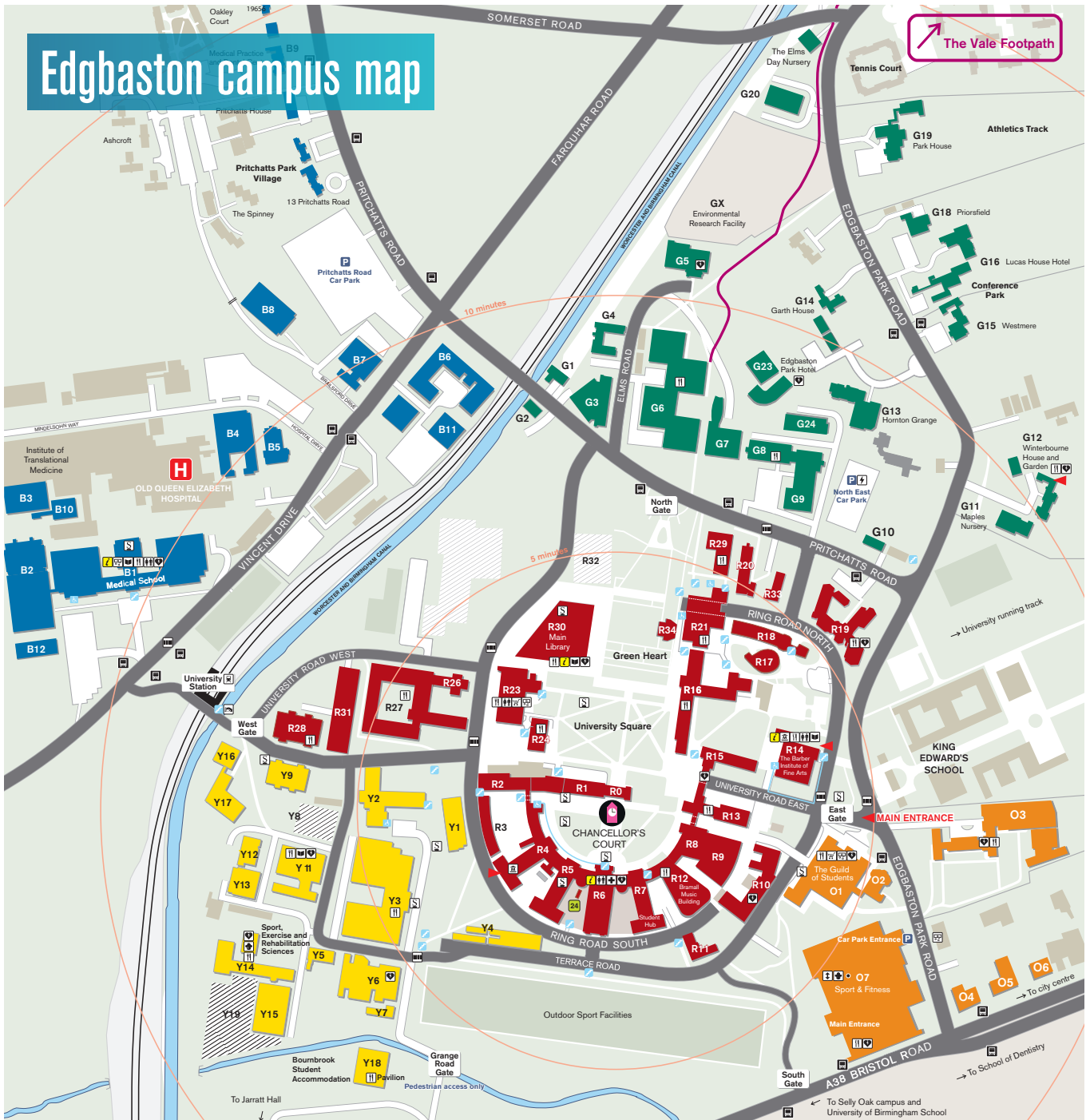
LAPWORTH MUSEUM OF GEOLOGY
