



# Your Welcome checklist

## It's almost time... are you ready for your Welcome?

We know there's a lot to take in before you arrive, so, here's a handy checklist of some of the key things you need to tick off as soon as possible...

### First things first.

Have you completed your **online registration**? Check your emails and do this first to get your student username and password. Make sure you have a passport-style photograph ready to upload.

### Get your student ID Card.

If you're a student based in the UK, complete Online Registration by Sunday 3 September to get your **student ID card** posted to you at your home address. If not, you'll be able to collect your ID card on arrival.

### International student?

You may need to complete some extra essential tasks such as providing copies of important documents to prove you have the right to study in the UK. Use **My Right to Study** to provide these online before you arrive.

### Supporting your studies.

If you have a disability, specific learning difficulty, long term medical condition or mental health condition, **get in touch** as soon as possible to discuss how we can support you.

### Your new home.

For **university accommodation**, check your emails and log onto the Accommodation Portal as soon as you can. Looking for private accommodation? Our **Community Living team** can help.

### Pack your important documents.

From your passport to prescription copies, don't forget to have your important documents at hand. You may need these during your time at UoB. We also recommend packing enough medication until you've registered with a doctor here.

### Read your emails.

We've got a lot of important information that we need to share with you before you get here so check your emails weekly to stay in the loop! Don't forget to login to your **new student email account** too.

### Download the MyUoB app.

A must have resource for all students. Our app is **free to download** for iOS and Android devices – get it now.

### Organise your finances.

If you haven't already done so, make sure you know how your fees are being paid, and when you'll get your **student finance payments** (if applicable).

### Plane, train, or car?

Whether you're coming from a different country, or from just down the road, make sure you **plan your journey to campus** well in advance.
