### **FAQs**



#### What Loan Boxes are on offer?

The museum offers educational loans boxes; including Rocks and Fossils sets. Please book up to 6 weeks in advance so as to allow our Education team to gather the resources.

### Are there any restrictions for loan boxes?

Our loan boxes can be borrowed for a maximum of 2 weeks including school holidays. If you have any specific requests, please speak with the Learning & Community Development Officer.

### How do I get the Loan Box?

We ask that all schools / groups requiring our loan boxes make arrangements to pick up and return the loan boxes with our Learning & Community Development Officer. The boxes cannot be posted and the Lapworth Museum will not deliver the boxes to schools.

Please note our loan boxes are often quite heavy so it is advised to collect the box in a car or for multiple people to collect the box.

To collect and return the loan box by car, please arrange a specific day with the Learning and Community Development Officer who will arrange for the loan boxes to be available behind the museum's reception desk during museum opening hours (10am-5pm during week days and 12noon-5pm at weekends). Parking on campus is restricted between the hours of 8am and 6pm Mon – Fri. Please check parking restrictions if you are staying longer than pick up and drop off of the loan box.

It is for this reason that we ask all teachers and pupils to treat our objects with respect and care. Please note that some of the objects can be heavy and can have sharp parts (teeth!).

Within the boxes you will find information on each object as well as activities to go alongside the objects.
