Catalyst funding for pump-priming projects is available to support our Network members in bacterial vaccinology to explore new approaches and strategies to advance their vaccines in partnership with LMICs and industry and acquire the data to support substantive funding applications.

Pump-priming projects

- Projects are required to align to one of the following:
 - Focus on pathogens with outbreak potential
 - Tackle the global AMR challenge
- Additionally, priority will be given to projects that:
 - Target the pre-clinical/clinical bottleneck
 - Generate novel partnerships between UK, Industry, LMIC partners
 - Demonstrate a clear plan for future funding potential
 - Confirm that research governance is already in place
- Typically, £50k for a maximum of 6 months

- Network membership is a prerequisite
- Submission deadline 06 October 2024
- All projects must end by 31 August 2025
