Interview selection process:

For non WP applications, applications are assessed on the below primary factors, although other factors are also relevant:

- Minimum entry requirements (achieved or not, no extra credit for exceeding)
- Personal statement – motivation to do the course, specific mentions of Dentistry and reasoning behind application
- UCAT score: The UCAT cut-off for interview varies annually dependent upon the number of applications and UCAT scores of those applicants.
