Interview selection process:

For non widening participation applications, applications are assessed on the below primary factors, although other factors are also relevant:

- a) Minimum entry requirements (achieved or not, no extra credit for exceeding)
- b) Personal statement motivation to do the course, specific mentions of Dentistry and reasoning behind application
- c) UCAT score: The UCAT cut-off for interview varies annually dependent upon the number of applications and UCAT scores of those applicants.
