After 8 years, BASIL-2 is approaching the Finish Line.

This Newsletter outlines how you can help ensure we successfully complete the trial and achieve a complete and accurate dataset.



WHY AM I GETTING SO MANY BASIL-2 EMAILS?

We need to collect all trial data and get it ready for analysis. This includes:

- All forms that are due up to 30 November 2022
- Any forms which we are missing from earlier in the trial
- Queries arising from completed forms
- Queries from statistical checks—these aren't done until the end of the study

So, you may be getting more emails than usual, but the good news is—this will only be for a few weeks—as the cut off for data is 7th November.

FOLLOW UPS—AND OTHER FORMS

The follow up period (e.g. 24mths, 36 mths etc) depends on your trial start date. Any follow ups due by **30 November 2022** should be completed by 31 October 2022.

We will be sending a list of follow up forms, and /or any other forms due.

Absolute cut off for receipt of completed forms is 7 November 2022

Please let us know if you are unable to obtain data; if a patient has died/withdrawn please send exit form



DATA QUERIES (DCFs)

Please contact us if you want to discuss any queries, or you think you have provided data/form.

Please respond to all queries by 7 November 2022



INVOICES

Most sites can claim payment for each patient recruited—1 payment at Baseline and 1 payment when all data collection completed—check your site agreement for details

Some sites still have to claim payments, so please check with your finance office.
