I understand that all information collected will be used for medical research only and that I will not be identified in any way in the analysis and reporting of the results.	
6.	I agree to the use of anonymous quotes in the reporting of the study.	
7.	Anonymised data from this study may be used for teaching purposes or shared with other Universities/ third parties for research purposes. I agree to my anonymised data being shared. (Optional)
