The protocol has also been amended to compensate for the withdrawal from the qualitative aspect of the study and the review of concomitant medications at each hospital visit.

Predict and prevent_v5.0 Vd06-Oct-2020

This amendment is to also inform you that due to the COVID-19 outbreak we have made the difficult decision to pause the saliva collection element of the study until further notice.

We have not activated a site for the trial as of yet, but site staff will be notified of this pause prior to site activation. This pause will be implemented for all sites on the same day of first site activation.
