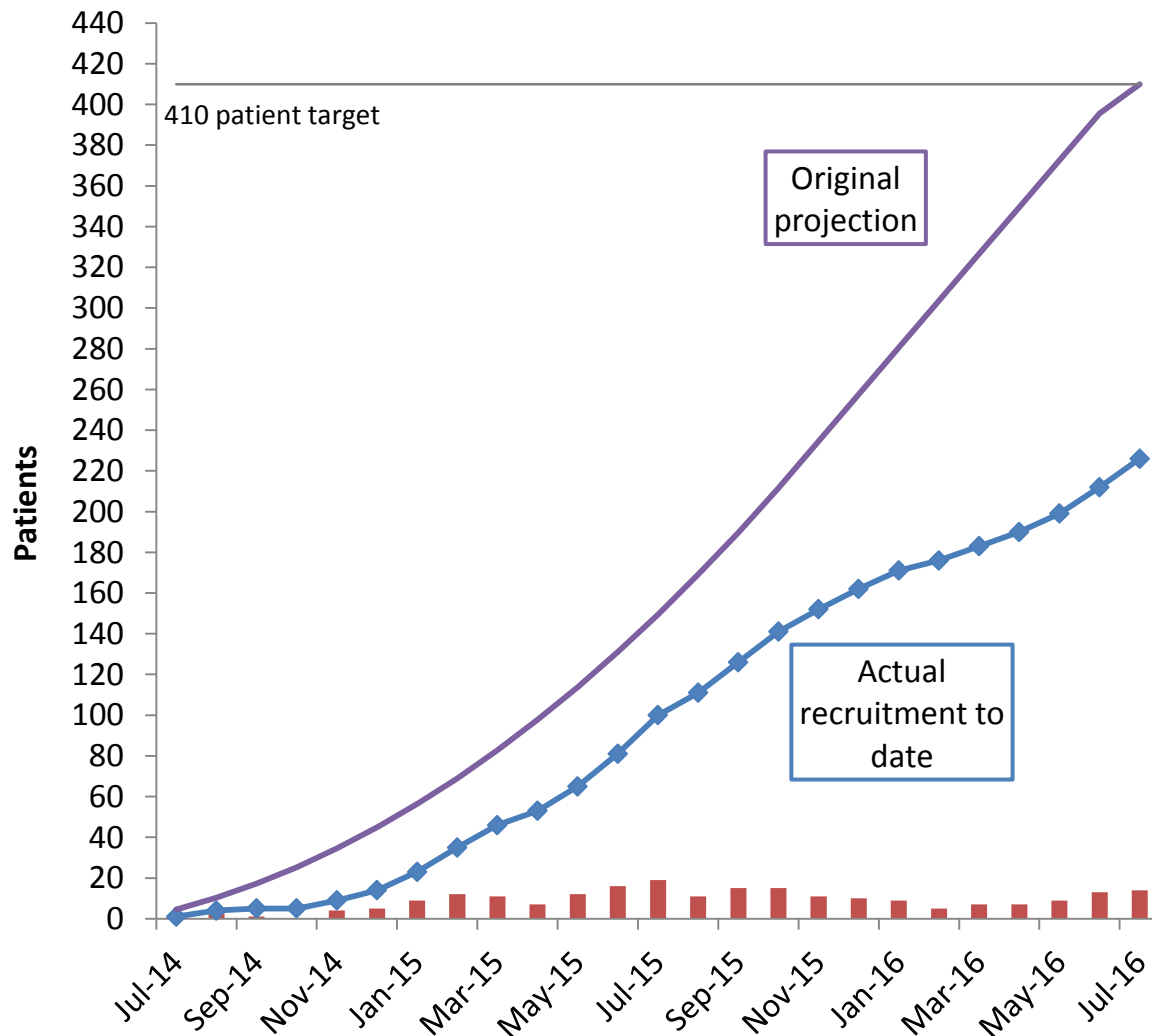

Recruitment



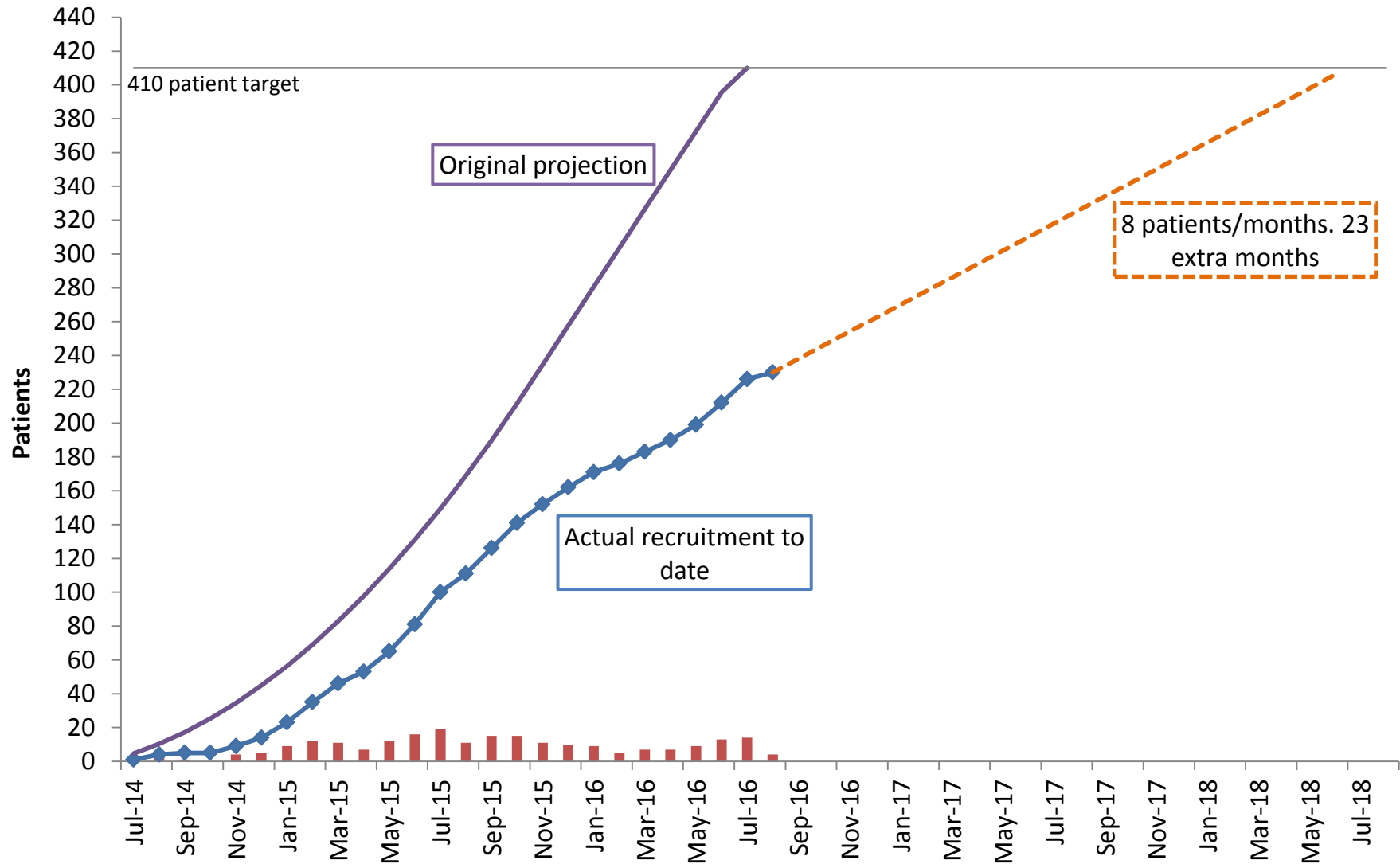
Original projection: 1.1 patient per site per month, opening 1 site each month up to 20 sites

Actual overall rate: 9 patients per month across 33 sites

Revised target in proposed extension: 8 patients per month = 2 more years



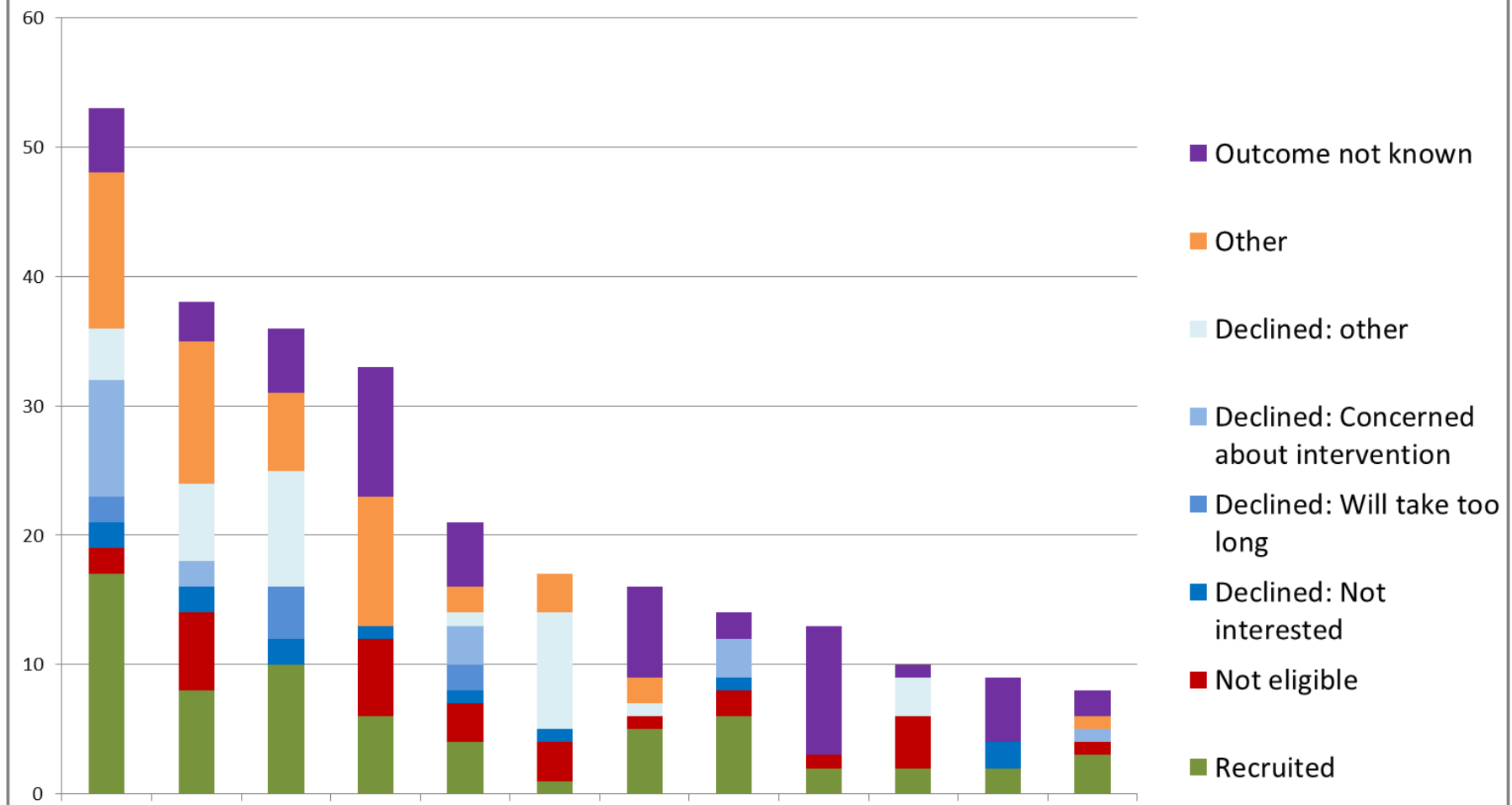

Recruitment – success rates

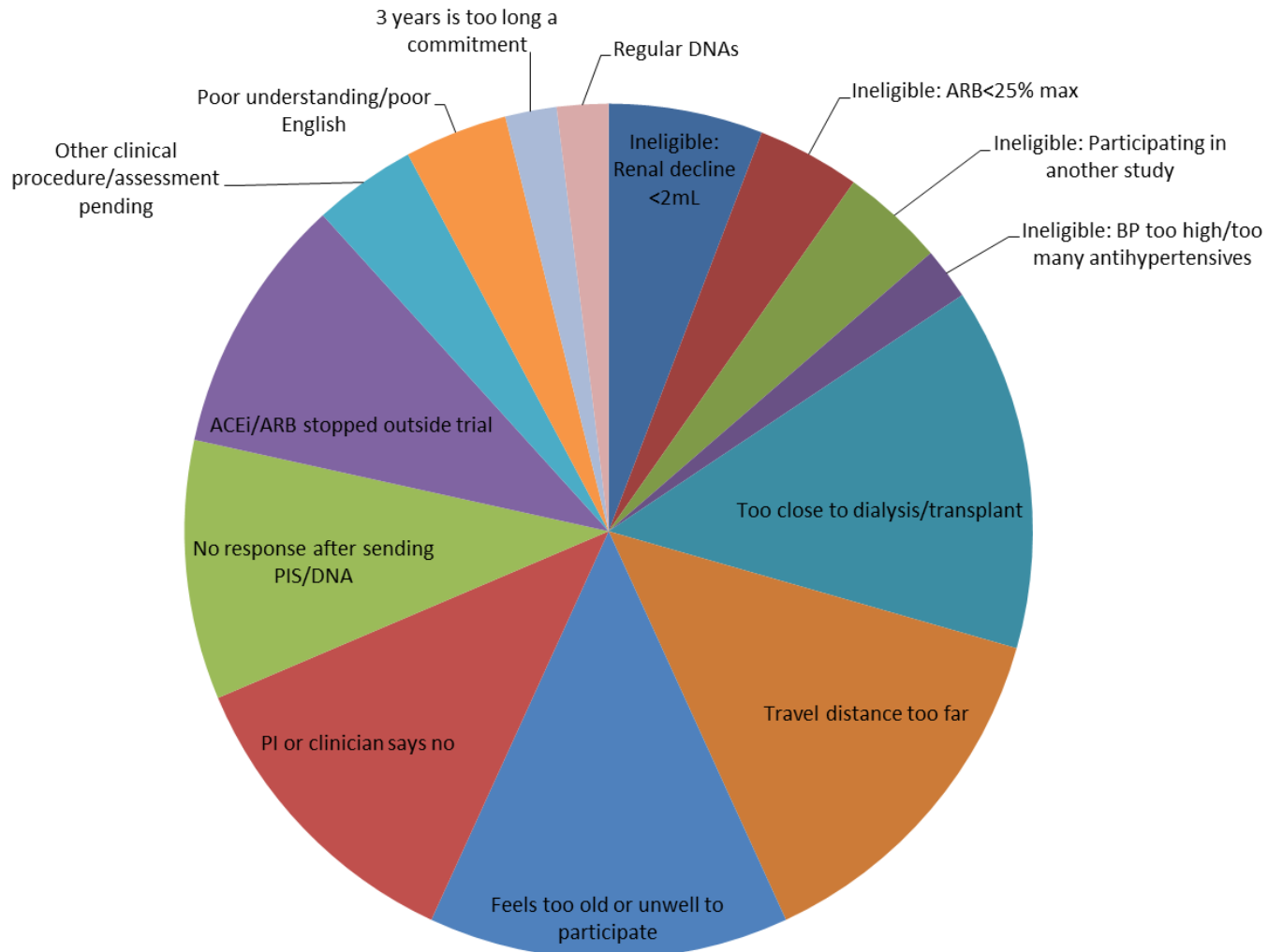
Graph showing recruitment outcomes for patients that are approached about participation in STOP-ACEi

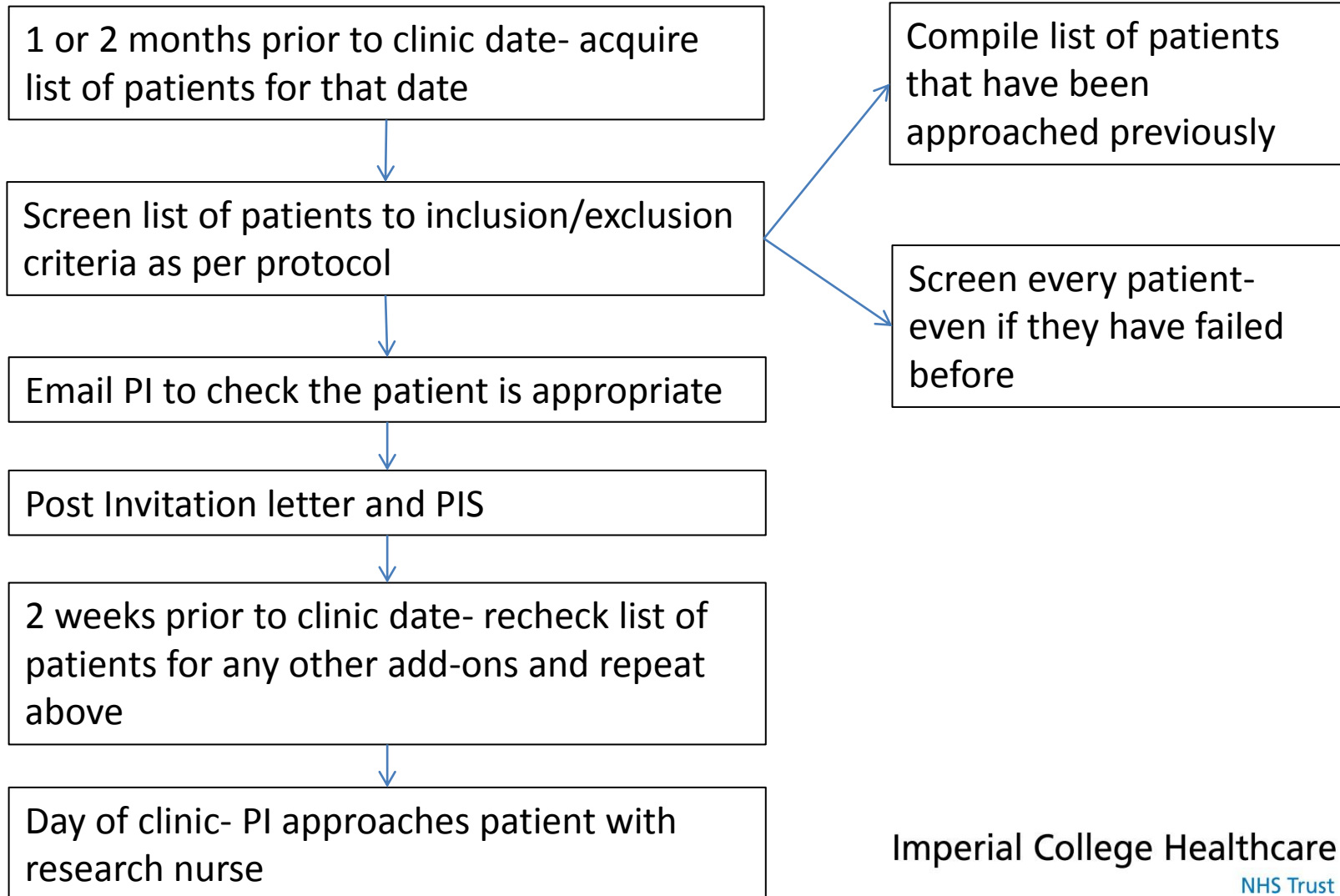
