(ACE impro maint	study is designed to test whether stopping treatment with angiotensin converting enzyme inhibitors i) and/or angiotensin receptor blockers (ARB), compared to carrying on with these treatments, can ve or stabilise kidney function in patients who have chronic kidney disease (CKD), while aining blood pressure control. To enter the trial, participants must be aged 18 years or over, be a ACEi and/or ARB treatment and have CKD stage 4 or 5.
