

# **MESSAGE FROM OUR CI**

'It has been a year full of landmarks for the trial, as we opened our first sites and recruited our first patients. As we enter into 2025 we will be pushing for new sites to open and for recruitment to pick up. We are planning an amendment after listening to you, to help with recruitment and will keep you updated. Professor Whitehouse has recently taken a 6 month sabbatical and I (Dhruv Parekh) am stepping in as interim CI along with Deputy-CI, Ingeborg Welters. # TRIAL UPDATE

- A protocol amendment to align the inclusion/exclusion criteria with standard of care has been submitted to the Sponsor for review. The amendment also aims to streamline the training and delegated duties for those confirming eligibility and randomising only.

# **DATA ENTRY TIPS!**

- ★ Queries which need resolving can be found in the resolve issues tab on the left hand side of the REDCap homepage.
- ★ If you want to add additional information, leave the field blank which will prompt a query to be raised. The additional data can then be added when responding to the query.
- ★ Following a preliminary data review, our stats team have requested all missing data is completed with the 'UNK' missing data code going forward. This differs from the previous advice given, apologies for any confusion.
- ★ If a person's name does NOT appear in the dropdown list for confirming eligibility or form completion at randomisation this is because we do NOT have all their paperwork so they cannot confirm eligibility until this has been receievd by the trial team.
- ★ If a participant is discharged from ICU between baseline and day 7 complete the ICU discharge form and no further daily assessment forms.
