Message from the Chief Investigator



Dear CaPE Investigators,

Happy new year! We have started 2024 on a very positive note, with recommencement of recruitment since mid-January, after delivery of Campaign 2 IMP to all sites. We thank you for your patience over the last 2 months and for continuing to screen for eligible women.

CaPE now has 39 sites open with 576 women recruited, and the last 51 participants have been recruited in just two weeks. A special thank you to all the sites that have hit the ground running. We have released more lottery numbers for prizes to win over February and March.

Recruitment for the trial will continue until at least September 2024, with potential for a further extension thereafter. NIHR HTA has approved the opening of an additional 20 sites, (total 60 sites) to meet recruitment targets. A further 20 sites are in various stages of set up, and we continue to approach other sites directly and through the CRN. The HTA have also recognised your hard work in keeping recruitment going and have agreed to a per patient payment of £40 for CaPE. This will be implemented for any participants recruited from January 2024 and will be reflected in a revised MnCA that we will circulate soon.

We have our second Data Monitoring Committee meeting this month and this will be followed by the Trial Steering Group Meeting. We will keep you updated on their feedback.

I am planning to reach out to the research teams in each of our recruiting sites individually over the next few months to hear more about your personal experience with running CaPE locally. We'd really like your feedback on how we can do things better, and if there is anything we can do to support you. 
Two weekly CaPE Queries online drop in sessions

CaPE Recruitment to Date

With IMP now delivered to all sites, we've already seen a swift surge in recruitment figures. January saw 29 recruits, a great start considering IMP was only delivered to sites over the last 2 weeks of that month. We're very pleased to let you know that February is continuing in that vein, with 52 participants already recruited at time of writing (15.2.24)! This is outstanding and looks like we are shaping up for a record breaking month, so huge thank-you all, please keep up the excellent work!

TIPS: Eligibility Criteria

We've had some queries on eligibility criteria from sites and this is just a reminder that you CAN recruit:

- women who have high blood pressure at <20 weeks but no other features of preeclampsia (e.g, protein in the urine, abnormal liver or kidney function or growth problems in the baby)
- women who are on medication for chronic hypertension
- women on anticoagulant medication
- women who are ELIGIBLE for aspirin *but not taking it* out of choice or because of contraindications
- women with some autoimmune diseases are eligible, for example anti-phospholipid syndrome or lupus as they are at increased risk of pre-eclampsia, but not all autoimmune diseases are associated with increased risk so please continue to contact the CaPE Team if you have any queries about particular autoimmune
