Present at your clinical governance / MDT meetings to raise awareness of the trial



The participant can continue in the giant PANDA study as previously! We anticipate that many women will be in this situation and we have a place to record all of these changes in the eCRF. The woman should complete the follow-up surveys as previously and the outcome data should be completed within 6 weeks of birth/ end of pregnancy. Procedures: Blood and urine samples (no extra appointments), and up to 3 episodes of 24 hour blood pressure monitoring + participant diary
