Thank you to those who were able to join and contributed to this month's virtual meeting!

Last month we noticed more participants were recruited to the observational arm than to the randomised trial. There was a useful discussion with lots of sites participating, around overcoming the barriers to recruitment and how to re-approach women to offer randomisation.

Key points when offering randomisation:

- ♦ 50% chance that they stay on the current medication
- ♦ 50% chance they change
- ♦ If they do change, they may prefer the new medication
- ♦ If they do not like the new medication they can switch back to the current medication (just like clinical care) and their experience still counts, helping us to improve care
