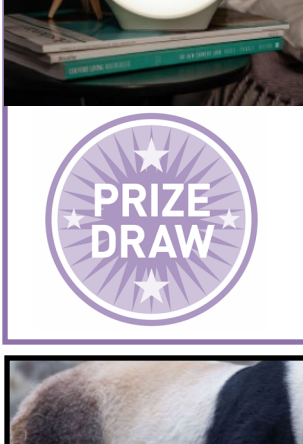


Pregnancy ANtihypertensive Drugs: which Agent is best?

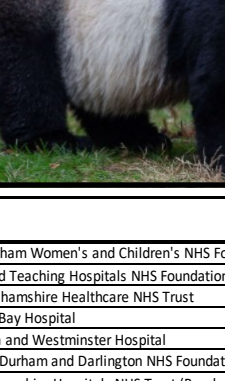
Prize Draw for Healthcare Professionals in March:

For each eligible woman you refer to your local research team, you will get one entry into the prize draw to win a **Lumie Sunrise Alarm Clock** (even if the woman decides not to join the trial).

The Lumie Sunrise Alarm Clock is a wake-up light that simulates a sunrise to help rouse you from sleep.

The woman must be screened on the REDCap database.

The referrer's name and email address should be emailed to the giant PANDA study team.




The giant PANDA study is 9 months old! 27 sites (26 Trusts) are now open and 224 participants have been randomised.

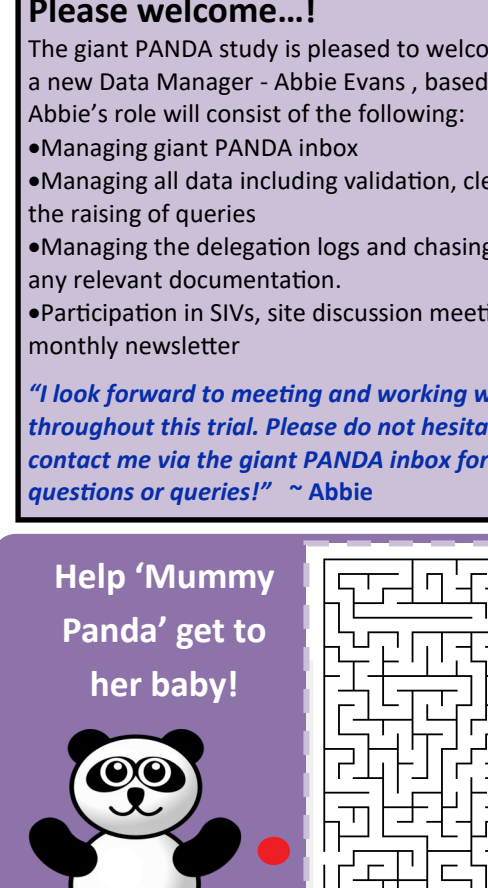

PLEASE NOTE: From next month, we will be reporting completion of two-week follow-ups, outcome data and outstanding queries - overall and by maternity

Tips to increase completion of two-week follow-ups:

- Ensure the woman understands why the two-week follow-up is so important to the giant PANDA study—it provides the woman's perspective on the antihypertensive medication she has been prescribed (e.g. side effects, satisfaction, how she takes it, etc.) and when she should expect to receive it and complete it by.
- Ensure you have entered the woman's correct mobile number and email in the REDCap
- The link to the two-week follow-up will be sent two-weeks after consent (to the second!). Put a reminder in your team diary at 2 weeks +2 days to check REDCap to see if she has completed. If she has, there will be a green tick 
- The participant can complete the follow-up survey via sms survey link or in person (e.g. in clinic) over the phone, or via email survey link.
- The follow-up can be translated by the research team using routine translation services (e.g. Language Line) for women who require a translator

Have you responded to your data queries on REDCap?



1. Login to REDCap
2. Click on 'Resolve Issues' (bottom left-hand side) which will list all queries
3. You can see the query and any updated response according to participant id
4. Please update eCRF (if applicable) and respond to the query to say what you have done (for audit trail)
5. Set aside a time to check back regularly (monthly) for new queries
