The feedback was incredibly positive. You told us that you found the sessions useful overall but also were able to clarify specific points about the study.

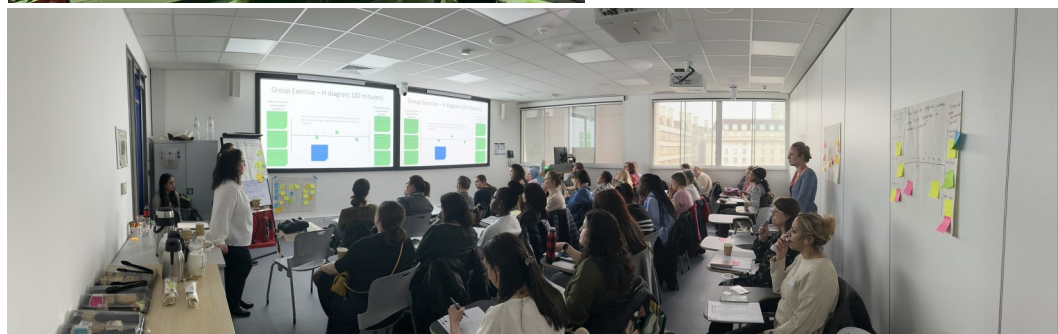
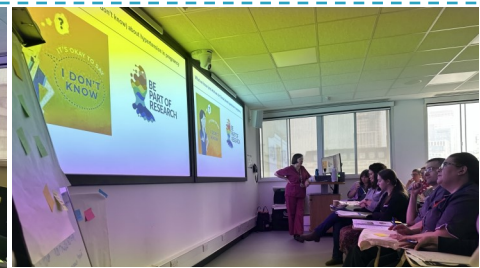
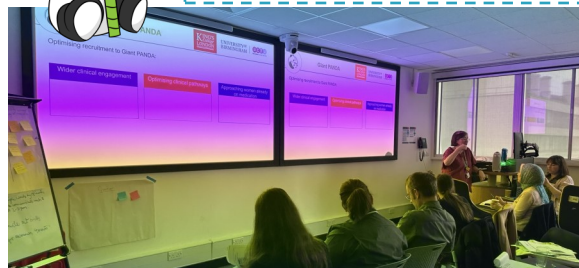
You told us that you feel more confident about approaching women about Giant PANDA and engaging with the wider team about the trial! This is great news.
