Keep telling us your feedback so that we can make recruiting easier and smoother.



#### Well done Giant PANDA sites!

During February/March 2023, over 1000 queries were raised in anticipation of our TSC and DMC meetings. In just 4 weeks, you have smashed this out of the park and got the number down to just 35 remaining queries. Please give yourselves all a metaphorical pat-on-the-back! (Or a literal one if you fancy it.)

Please find below a list of the most commonly occurring queries and how to avoid these moving forwards:

- Missing Forms/Sections/Fields— the most common query that covered over 75% of all queries raised, was that of missing forms, sections or fields within the database. Please ensure that every single field on a form is completed and should any data not have been captured, please let us know within the query bubble for that specific field.
- Missing blood pressure readings— if a blood pressure reading was not taken on either the antenatal inpatient or outpatient forms, please ensure that you tick the relevant box to say that it was not taken as to avoid a query being raised.
- ♦ Diagnosis of pre-eclampsia— on the Maternal Outcomes form, within both the "before birth" and "after birth" sections, there is the question: "Did the woman have a diagnosis of pre-eclampsia or superimposed pre-eclampsia after birth (up to discharge or 28 days post birth)?". If the woman had a diagnosis of pre-eclampsia when she enrolled, please always select "NA (enrolled with pre-eclampsia)" for this question.
