Pregnancy ANtihypertensive Drugs:

Which Agent is best?







At the end of June a total of 1124 women have been randomised into the study!



We have nearly reached the half-way mark of 1150 women!

Data from over 2000 women, show that when

For every 4 women approached

50% take part in the trial

25% take part in the observational arm

25% don't take part

For every 4 women approached, 2 women will agree to be randomised to either medication.

REMINDER: Women can move from the observational study to the trial (provided they meet the eligibility criteria). See the document attached which provides a step by step instructions on how to do this in REDCap.

Thank you to all the sites that attended the last virtual meeting it approaching a woman who is eligible for the trial was wonderful to see all your faces! There was discussion between sites on screening and recruiting women to the randomisation part of the trial: Top tips included:

- Offer the trial to every eligible woman with hypertension
- Screen antenatal lists for women who have chronic or gestational hypertension. Be visible in the clinical areas
- Please 'Just ask' these women if they would be happy to be randomised. We have had feedback that a particularly good time to reapproach these women is when their medication needs to be switched/

Provide training for clinical staff about Giant PANDA. If you would like the Giant PANDA team to support you with this please do ask!

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New study highlights importance of understanding infant side effects of antihypertensive agents in pregnancy

Study summary: A new study published in BJOG in June found that more than 1 in 10 late preterm infants (34⁺⁰- 36⁺⁶) and 1 in 20 term infants (37⁺⁰ onwards) admitted to Neonatal Units in the UK are associated with a maternal hypertensive disorder of pregnancy (HDP). Respiratory disease and hypoglycaemia were the primary drivers of admission in HDP infants, with HDP infants being more than twice as likely as non-HDP infants to be admitted for hypoglycaemia. Overall 1 in 4 HDP infants received interventions for hypoglycaemia alone.

How is this related to Giant PANDA?

The evidence on infant side effects of antihypertensive agents taken during pregnancy is thin. Giant PANDA will provide high quality evidence around the infant side effects, including hypoglycaemia, of nifedipine and labetalol. If the trial finds infant hypoglycaemia risk varies substantially between these two medications, the results will help improve evidence based recommendations on optimal antihypertensive choice around the time of delivery. This might reduce the proportion of HDP infants requiring NNU care for management of hypoglycaemia, reducing separation of mothers and their infants.

We owe it to women and their babies to know which antihypertensive agent is best - keep up the good work!






Hi everyone,
