


Is your Labour being Induced?

This hospital is involved in a national study involving women who are having their labour induced




As many as one in three first time women will have their labour induced

Up to three in five women need an oxytocin drip to increase contractions as part of the induction process

All over the country, the same standard dose of oxytocin is used

iHOLDS is a study comparing higher dose oxytocin against the standard dose used to see if it improves the chance of having a vaginal birth



The care you receive will be the same whether or not you decide to join the trial.
