Site Initiations/ Q&A Sessions

Site initiations are be in the format of pre-recorded video presentation slides followed by live virtual Q&A sessions with the Chief Investigators and trials office team, hosted on Zoom.

Site staff can access the pre-recorded presentation online via <u>YouTube</u> or the <u>trial website</u> at their convenience.

You will be asked to self-certify that you have watched the pre-recorded video as evidence of trial training prior to joining a Q&A session. We will also be asking you to register for the Q&A session you will be attending; please do not share the Zoom meeting link details team colleagues, as the registration details will provide us with a record of attendees for report writing purposes.

The PI and any Associate PIs must do this before the trial can open at their centre, though we recommend that anyone involved in research activities for the trial does so too.

Current CVs (signed within the last 12 months): required for the PI, Associate PI, plus any other staff that will be performing research activity for the trial at your site.

NIHR Associate PI Scheme

People who would not normally have the opportunity to take part in clinical research in their day to day role have the chance to experience what it means to work on and deliver a NIHR portfolio trial under the mentorship of an enthusiastic local PI.

Participating healthcare professionals receive formal recognition of engagement in NIHR Portfolio research studies through the certification of Associate PI status, endorsed by the NIHR and Royal Colleges.

When completing the delegation log, training and sending over your CV/GCP Certificate, there are a few requirements:

CV

 Should be wet ink signed and dated within 12 months (or as per your trust policy)

GCP Certificate

• Should be dated within the last 2 years (or as per your trust policy)

Delegation Log & Training

When completing the delegation log there is corresponding training that must be completed depending on the tasks/ roles you have been delegated:

The following responsibilities should only be performed by a doctor/clinician:

- D Confirm patient eligibility
- F Prescribing of investigational product
- H Assesses SAEs
- O Training of clinicians to perform intratympanic injections
- P Perform intratympanic injections

The following responsibility should only be performed by the PI:

• K - CRFs and DCFs review and sign off (PI only)

The following responsibility should only be performed by an Audiologist:

- Q Perform AB words test
- R Perform pure tone audiogram (blinded assessment)

Training must have been performed for any role related responsibilities, see below:

Responsibility key on Delegation Log Training required

- **C** Obtain informed consent Video part 1: Introduction and Consent (3 mins)
- **P** Perform intratympanic injections Video part 2: Local Anaesthetic Technique (2 mins)
- **P** Perform intratympanic injections Video part 3: Steroid Injection Technique (2 mins)
- **Q** Perform AB word test Video part 4: AB Word Testing (9 mins)
- Initially as long as all responsibilities have been covered by the site staff, further staff members can be added later (with the exception of AB word testing)
- Audiologists are not required to appear on the log if performing their normal job role (standard of care), however AB word testing training is mandatory

Emails:

We appreciate that some emails are lengthy, however they do all contain important information. Please ensure all emails are read fully on receipt.

Screening Log:

Please ensure dummy data is entered on the TRAINING database and not the live database

Please ensure the Screening Log is fully completed in a timely manner

Database Passwords:

Passwords for the STARFISH database will only last for 6 months. They will then need to be reset.

A reminder for staff to check all QOL booklet pages are complete before the patient leave, as we are getting some blank pages.

SAE reporting:

The STARFISH online database will be available over the Christmas period. SAEs should be reported in the usual manner as per the SAE Reporting Guidelines which can be found in section 13.1 of the ISF or via the website link: www.birmingham.ac.uk/research/bctu/trials/renal/starfish/starfish-database.aspx

Please ensure that the causality assessment is made by a medically qualified doctor as soon as possible.
