As of the 31st July 2021, we have **31** sites actively open to recruitment, and we have **193** randomised participants! **13** of those were in July (with **12** consented).

Monthly recruitment


Our best ever figures saw 14 randomised and 15 consented in the months of January and November 2020. Let's see if we can overtake those numbers in August!

Database: Data queries

- ⇒ Run the 'Active Data Queries' report and overdue CRF report to check for queries.
- ⇒ Complete CRFs as soon as you can when they are due.
- ⇒ Look out for the 'Data Query Management' emails ,which may detail queries that cannot be raised directly on the database, e.g. queries on CRFs 2, 8 and 9.

Common gueries to avoid

Screening Form: (updating and re-screening)

⇒ Don't forget to update the 'date of screening' to 'date of consent'. Click 'Calculate GA' and change the 'date of form completion'. (The date of consent & date of screening should be the same.)

- Maternal outcome form: 'Maternal complication section'

 ⇒ Remember to answer 'Intensive therapy unit (ITU) admission' with Yes or No.
- ⇒ Answer the question 'confirm all the above have been considered' (on all CRFs)
- ⇒ When **'other'** is selected check if you could select a response form the list provided.
- Add any further information in the **'CRF notes box'** to explain any information that may differ/vary e.g., date a medication was stopped and a new one commenced.
