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# **WILL Trial**



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November is about bonfires and fireworks, and WILL is beginning to 'rocket' again as we celebrate reaching milestones and our best month ever for recruitment!



## Site and participant update:

As of the 31st October 2021, we have **36** sites actively open to recruitment, and we have **230** randomised participants! **15** of those were in October. Welcome to **Walsall Manor Hospital**, our newest site to join us. Congratulations and thank you to the following sites:

Western Sussex Hospitals, King's College Hospitals, St Mary's Maternity Unit Poole, and King's Mill Hospital for consenting and randomising 2 participants each.

Bradford Royal Infirmary, New Cross Hospital, Singleton Hospital, Royal Victoria Infirmary and Leicester Royal Infirmary for consenting and randomising 1 participant each.

**St. Georges Hospital** for consenting **1** and randomising **2** participants. **Royal Berkshire Hospital** for consenting **1** participant.

#### Best month for recruitment: October!

We did it! October was the best month ever for recruitment in WILL so far. Our previous best month was 14 randomised participants and we ended the month with **15** randomised.

#### Milestones reached: 20% of the consented and randomised targets



**Congratulations** to **St Georges Hospital** for randomising our **216**<sup>th</sup> participant and **King's Mill Hospital** for consenting our **235**<sup>th</sup> participant - also their **1st** participants too. Fantastic! Hope you enjoyed your thank you gift.

A **MASSIVE** thank you to all of you for helping us reach these targets and to all the women for taking part. Lets keep up this great work and aim higher.

## Database: Options for completing/updating screening form

Screening forms should to be completed/updated to indicate why a woman was not consented to the trial. To do this:

- Change the date of screening to reflect the date in her maternity notes when it was established that the woman would not be participating.
- All the eligibility criteria need to be reconsidered and changes made if necessary.
- Consider the following scenarios for the woman:
  - 1. <u>Has given birth before she reached the eligibility window</u>: select **Not applicable, previously screened and now post-partum**.
  - 2. Unable to be contacted within eligibility window or has been missed and is **still pregnant**: recalculate the GA, select **No** to **Gestational age of 36**<sup>+0</sup>-37<sup>+6</sup>? and add further information in the CRF notes box.
  - Unable to be contacted within eligibility window or has been missed and has given birth: change the date of screening to after the EDD, select Now post-partum and write in the CRF notes box 'unable to contact between 36<sup>+0</sup>-37<sup>+6</sup>."
