Site and participant update:

As of the 31st January 2022, we have **40** sites actively open to recruitment, and we have **268** randomised participants! **13** of those were in January.

Congratulations and thank you to the following sites:

• Leicester Royal Infirmary for consenting and randomising an amazing 4 participants.

• King's Mill Hospital for consenting and randomising 2 participants.



• St Mary's Maternity Unit, Poole and Western Sussex Hospitals for consenting 1 and randomising 2 participants each.

• James Cook University Hospital, Singleton Hospital and Royal Victoria Infirmary for consenting and randomising 1 participant.

Target milestone: Our overall randomisations are at 24.8%



We are only **2** participants away from reaching our next milestone of **25% - 270 randomised participants.** Could it be your team that reaches this? The race is on! A gift will be sent to the site that randomises number 270!



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GOAL!

Exclusion criteria/Contraindication to trial arm

If you answer **Yes** to the question **'Contraindication to either one of the trial arms'**, a list of possible reasons will appear, such as:

- Evidence of pre-eclampsia
 GDM with poor glycaemic control
- GDM with poor give
- GDM on oral hypoglycaemic agent
- Planned elective Caesarean
- Chronic kidney disease
- Obesity (BMI \geq 30kg/m²)
- Care-provider does not want woman to participate

Please note: except for Evidence of pre-eclampsia the reasons listed are <u>not</u> exclusions for WILL. However, they may be *perceived* to be by some doctors and we would like to collect this information. For example, a woman with obesity (BMI $\geq 30 kg/m2$) is eligible for WILL, but her doctor may think there will be an increased risk if she were randomised to the expectant care at term group, or induction/elective Caesarean would be more difficult, so s/he is not happy for the woman to take part in the trial, and labels the situation as a contraindication to one of the trial arms.

You may find the training pages on the WILL website useful in discussions you have with women, their doctors or midwives. WILL would like to include women with co-morbidities as the results will be important to help guide their care.
