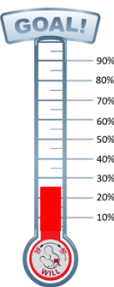


Site and participant update:

Vaginal Birth after Caesarean Section (VBAC):

Wording for women who desire a VBAC: Women who have a scar in their uterus, from either a prior Caesarean or other surgical procedure, are at a small (less than 1%) but increased risk of uterine rupture associated with labour. While this is true even when labour starts spontaneously, the risk of rupture is further increased by a small amount if prostaglandins are used to induce labour. Women who desire VBAC should be approached for WILL only at sites where the local protocol allows labour induction by methods other than use of prostaglandins, such as mechanical means.
