Site and participant update:

As of the 30th April 2022, we have **44** sites actively open to recruitment. We currently have **305** randomised participants! **9** of those were in April.

Changing the expectant care arm from 'at least 40⁺⁰'

WILL is submitting a proposal to NIHR, to change the control arm from "expectant care at term from at least 40⁺⁰ weeks" to "**Usual care at term"**, in response to a change in practice since the trial began, as emphasised by feedback from sites. We will keep you posted!

Remember: WILL is an important trial for women with hypertension in pregnancy and remains the #1 research priority highlighted in the 2021 NICE Inducing Labour guidelines (NG207). This change will keep the trial relevant. Keep up the fantastic work.

Database: Maternal Outcome form - updates: Proteinuria:

We have added the following definition of **Proteinuria** to consider when answering:

Did the woman develop proteinuria between consent and birth? Only select **yes** if the definition below is met.

≥2+ by dipstick, ≥30mg/mmol by spot protein:creatinine ratio, or ≥0.3g/d by 24hr urine collection

Example scenarios for when to enter data or not:

- Urinary dipstick negative/trace or +1 AND 34mg/mmol of spot protein:creatinine ratio (PrCr) enter data (because the spot PCR was ≥30mg/mmol)
- negative/trace or +1 and no to other questions do not enter (because definition of proteinuria was not satisfied in the first place)
- +2 or more and no to other questions enter data (woman had proteinuria)
- +2 or more AND 34mg/mmol of spot PrCr enter data
- 34mg/mmol of spot PrCr and no to other questions enter data

You will also be able to add spot protein:creatinine ratio results of <30mmg/mmol—only enter if other answers are **yes** and meet the definition of proteinuria.

PI sign off: Abnormal laboratory tests and Maternal complications sections:

It now states that 'This data will need verifying by the PI or delegate who has not been involved in the woman's care.' We have taken out 'medically-qualified delegate'. This is the same in the form completion details and verification section.

Verification role: we have created a new role on the database for staff whose **only** role is to verify data. They will **only** have access to the Maternal Outcome & Post-partum Management form to be able to verify data and enter information in the sign off section.


