

TRANSFER

WHO

- Pregnant women ≥ 16 years old
- Admitted with threatened preterm birth between 22+0-23+6 weeks' gestation

WHAT

- National prospective service evaluation
- Of care pathways following delivery for the most extremely preterm infants born between 22+0 and 23+6 weeks' gestation
- No study interventions
- No change to the patient pathway
- Only anonymised routinely collected data to be used

WHY

- To ensure that we can offer the highest level of care to women and their babies we must have a clear and accurate measurement of the impact of the 2019 BAPM recommendations on maternity services
- We will establish the incidence of women presenting with threatened preterm birth to obstetric units in the UK
- Data essential to facilitate adequate service provision and planning for obstetric and neonatal units throughout the UK
