Now open to recruitment! Two patients randomised in the first two months

With 3 trial sites now open, Basingstoke and North Hampshire Hospital, University College London Hospital and Withington Hospital Manchester, the trial has met its target of recruiting two patients in the first two months since opening the trial. With 2 more sites set to open this month, a further 3 in July and several patients in screening, recruitment is expected to continue to follow its targets. Thank you to everybody for your hard work and support, it is now paying off!
