Are you a social worker working in children's services?



Study seeking social workers who are:

- Employed by local authorities in England
- Working in children's services
- Willing to undertake a short, online training course (less than 2 hours) & complete surveys about their attitudes & knowledge regarding working with LGBTQ+ young people

We are looking for children's social workers in England to take part in a study testing the effectiveness of an online training programme for supporting LGBTQ+ young people.

The aim of the e-learning module is to improve social workers knowledge and skills in working with LGBTQ+ young people. The e-module is CPD accredited and will be offered free to participants and their organisations.

Participants will be randomly assigned to one of two groups: one group receiving the online training and the other receiving business-as-usual equality and diversity training from their local authorities. Both groups will be asked to complete surveys about their attitudes, knowledge and skills in working with LGBTQ+ young people.
