

Consultative notice: changes to Amphlett China Trust ('the Charity')

The University of Birmingham is the Trustee of the Charity¹. The University applied to the Charity Commission for a Scheme² for the Charity to broaden the terms of the Charity to benefit more students. The current terms of the Charity are restricted to provide a scholarship or maintenance for students studying Theology from China or students of a Chinese descent.

The proposed changes with the Scheme for the Charity will “advance education of students from China, Japan, Korea (South), Taiwan, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Brunei and Vietnam in the subject of Theology at the University of Birmingham”.
