Steps to gaining iQTS

1. Read more about iQTS

2. Check your eligibility

- A bachelor's degree from a UK or non-UK University
- GCSE maths grade 4 or equivalent
- GCSE science grade 4 or equivalent if teaching primary
- An IELTS score of 6.5 or higher, visit ielts.org

3. Choose a provider

- To apply for iQTS, visit the Get Into Teaching website

4. Apply for your course

- Apply directly to your chosen provider
- If accepted, complete a year-long course

5. Complete your training

- If you meet the iQTS Teachers' Standards you will be awarded iQTS
- Complete iQTS, and you'll be eligible to get English qualified teacher status (QTS) with no further fees or training
